

How to Choose a Utah Wedding Photographer

1. Visit the photographer's website and look at the quality of the photographs. Don't be distracted by a fancy website.
2. Do they give you the copyright allowing you to print your own reprints?
3. Make sure you understand everything you are getting with your wedding package.
4. Is the detail in the wedding dress visible in the photographer's photos? It is a common pitfall for many photographers to miss this detail.
5. Is there a limit to how many photos the photographer will take?
6. How long will the photographer stay at your wedding? Is it long enough to capture the beauty of your Utah Wedding?
7. Find a photographer who is interested in your ideas for photos and style.
8. Will the photographer capture your emotion in the photos or will he just pose you the same way he does with every wedding?
9. How soon will the photographer have your pictures available after the engagement, bridal sitting, or wedding?
10. Make sure the photographer has a contract to protect both of you so there is no question as to what is agreed upon.
11. Does the photographer give you multiple references for weddings she has done in the past?
