View the trailers/samples and ensure that you like the Videographer's work.

Make sure that you know exactly what it is that you're looking for before you book with the Videographer.

Are their prices within your budget?

Is the quality worth the price?

How quickly will the Videographer have your video to you?

Is the amount of time needed reasonable?

Does the Videographer have favorable references.

Here are few items you may consider in selecting your wedding video format:

Photomontage – this is a slideshow with your choice of soundtrack played at receptions showing childhood picture on up until dating/courtship.

Event – temple, ceremony, luncheon, rehearsal dinner, reception, etc.

Bridal – video shoot during photography session of bride in her wedding dress

Engagement – video shoot during photography session of announcement pictures

Date video

– video shoot of the two of you on a date

Interview – video shoot documenting how you first met your spouse to be and feelings shared up until engagement
